## Fire Chief's Report May Fire Department Update – April

## Fire Hazard Rating:

- The current fire hazard rating is **low**.
- Campfires and burn barrels are permitted.
- Category 2 and 3 burns still require a permit from the Fire Department.

#### **Fire Permits:**

• We have currently **stopped issuing burn permits**.

## **Call Volume Report:**

• The April call volume report is still **pending**.

## **Monthly Operational Review:**

- In early April, we met with **Minister Malcolmson** to discuss infrastructure and other concerns on Gabriola needs, especially **road conditions** on Gabriola.
- We are pleased to see **resurfacing on North Road** and hope improvements continue.
- Residents are encouraged to **send letters and photos** of poor road conditions to **info@gabriolafire.ca** so we can escalate these concerns.

## **Community Events and Initiatives:**

- On **April 26 and 27**, we hosted a **debris drop-off** event at Degnen Pit near Fire Hall #2.
- 213 loads were dropped off thank you to the FireSmart team and Carol Waldo, our FireSmart Coordinator.
- A group of our firefighters have started **installing address signs** as a **fundraiser** to support the child of a fellow firefighter who is battling leukaemia.
- This initiative has also **improved response times**—a big thank you to all involved.

## **Equipment Readiness:**

- Our **Type 2 tender**, also known as "*The Little Donkey*", is ready for deployment for the **2025 wildfire season**.
- Crews will be oriented and trained next week.
- We have giving impute on improvements on the **emergency dock** by replacing the **gangway** onto the float.
- We are advocating for a standpipe at the ramp to provide emergency water supply should the Taylor Bay hydrant be inoperable.

## **Upcoming Event:**

• The Gabriola Volunteer Fire Department Open House will be held on Saturday, May 10 during Emergency Preparedness Week.

## **Ongoing Projects:**

• We are doing some FireSmart at **Fire Hall #2**.

## **Staffing and Budget Consideration:**

- We are proposing the addition of a third Full Time Chief.
- Originally, we considered a **Captain** role, but we now recommend creating an **Assistant Chief** position.

- We ask that the **Trustees consider this proposal** and bring it to the **Finance Committee** at the **June meeting** for discussion.
- A **job description** will be presented at that time.
